City ambulance users at risk for ID theft

An employee of a private company that handles billing for City of Chicago ambulance service lost a laptop that contained personal information for 63,000 people who were billed for the service, WBBM-AM reports. The laptop was stolen from a car belonging to an employee of the contractor, DeZonia, the radio station reports.

A spokesman tells WBBM that the city's revenue department says the city will pay for a year of credit monitoring for anyone affected, and the private company may face punishment.
